



Patrick Martin was born in Abbeville (France) in 1963. He received his Ph.D. degree from the University of Picardie-Jules Verne in 1993 under the supervision of Professor P. Villa in the field of raw materials and glycochemistry. In 1994, he became Assistant Professor at the University of Picardie-Jules Verne in the Laboratoire des Glucides where he worked on amphiphilic glycomolecules with Professor Villa and in biological oligosaccharides synthesis with Professor Goethals. In 2000, he received his Habilitation and was promoted Professor in 2001 at the Université d'Artois (IUT Béthune). His current research interests are mainly in the field of natural product chemistry and reactivity like glycochemistry (surfactants, liquid crystals, drug targeting) and biomaterials. He is co-partner of a Interreg V Programm "SmartBioControl" on new biopesticides. He is the author of 104 international scientific publications and 5 patents.
