1985-1992: M.D; Doctorate of MEDICINE from Faculty of Medicine at Iran University of Medical Sciences, Tehran, Iran. Conducted research and presented a thesis entitled “pectus excavatum and pectus in carinatum” under the supervision of Prof. A. Shirinzadeh.

1998-2001 Ph.D in Medical Microbiology, with a thesis entitled “Detection of *Helicobacter pylori* in gastric biopsy by molecular assay and the comparison with RUT and Histopathology” under the supervision of Prof. A. Zargarizadeh and Prof F. Megraud. In this study a novel approach was developed a new specific assay for *H.pylori* detection. *H.pylori* is a small, Gram negative bacilli. *H.pylori* infection has a high prevalence in Iran (>80%).

It plays a key role in etiological agent of chronic gastritis, peptic ulcer, gastric cancer and lymphoma. A variety of invasive and non-invasive methods have been described for detection. Thus diagnose and treatment of *H.pylori* infection is very important. We designed a PCR which encoding gene Urease-C. In our study PCR assay had 98% sensitivity and 93% specificity. Therefore, this study established a sensitive and specific methodology for accurate detection of *H.pylori* infection without need for bacterial culture.


