He then rose to the rank of Associate Professor in 1983 and Full Professor 1991 at Cadi Ayyad University. He created the laboratory of bioorganic chemistry in 1987 His research works are focused on the design, synthesis and study of biological tools, anticancer and antiviral agents targeting nucleic acids. He has received two awards from Fullbright (1984, 2001). He published more than 200 publications.He had many collaboration for instance:
